There will be two judges officiating:

- One Campdraft Judge
- One Stockman's Challenge Judge

Competitors who have nominated for both the Encouragement Campdraft and the Stockman's Challenge will have their first-round Campdraft run judged simultaneously by both judges.

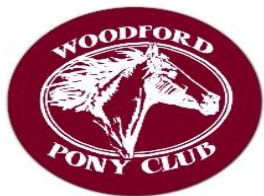
If a competitor is cracked off in the camp by the Campdraft Judge, their Campdraft run will conclude at that point. The Stockman's Challenge Judge will then take over, and the competitor will continue outside the camp to complete a Campdraft pattern, which will be judged as part of the Stockman's Challenge.

Competitors who have nominated only for the Encouragement Campdraft will have their run conclude if they are cracked off in the camp.

Competitors who have nominated only for the Stockman's Challenge will come into the arena during the first round and complete a Campdraft pattern, judged solely by the Stockman's Challenge Judge.

This format allows competitors entered in both events to complete their Stockman's Challenge run, even if their Campdraft run ends in the camp.

Competitors entered in both events will have their performances assessed within the same run, while maintaining separate judging requirements for each competition.

3. Two Horse Rule – Riders may enter 2 horses in the same age group only.

6. All Competitors to be FULLY MOUNTED and in **FORMAL UNIFORM** to compete & @Presentation to accept awards, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Our Biosecurity Plan

We take biosecurity seriously and have measures in place to mitigate the risk of infections, diseases and pests. Our event biosecurity plan is a set of preventative control measures and actions aimed at reducing the risk of infectious diseases and pests on and off the venue, and between horses at the venue.

What to expect in the unlikely event of a Biosecurity Incident

In the unlikely event of a biosecurity incident, the Biosecurity Manager and the organizing committee will implement our event biosecurity plan.

You will be notified about the incident and expected to follow the directions given by the organising committee.

Everyone will be expected to remain at the venue until cleared to leave by the organising committee and Biosecurity Manager.

In the event of horse movement restrictions participants are responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horses and themselves, including feeding, bedding, vets and personal needs.

If a horse is confirmed to have an infectious disease the owner/ lessee will be responsible for all vet cost and if venue is locked down and quarantined will be responsible for all cost associated with this.

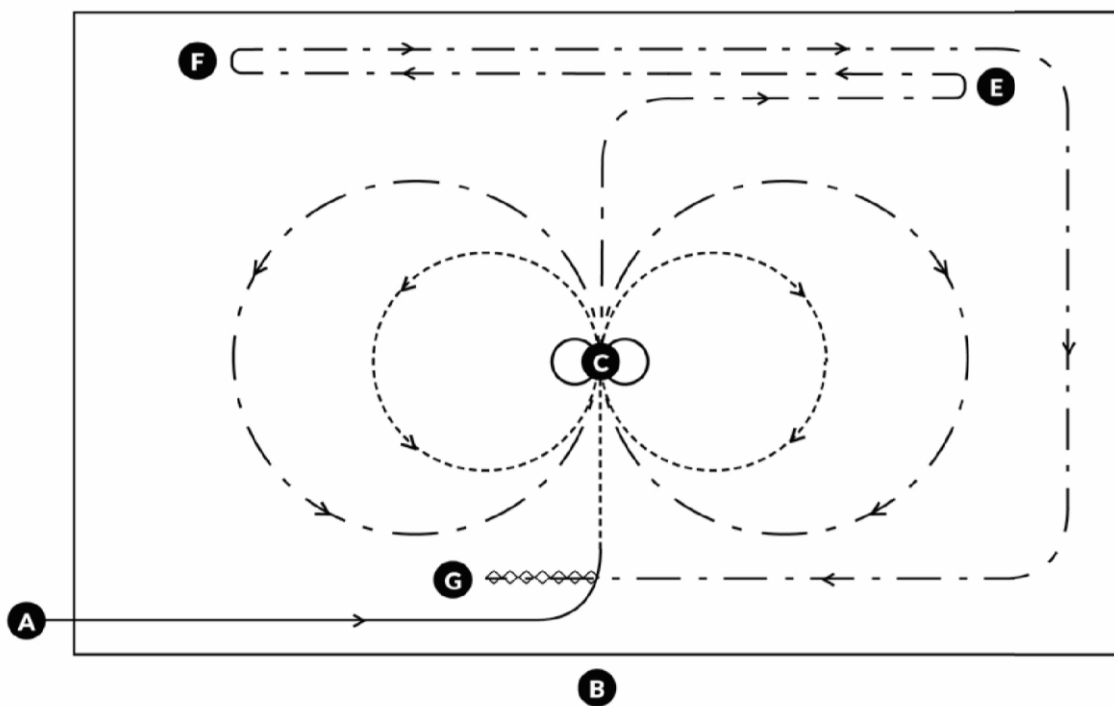

----- Trot - degree of collection

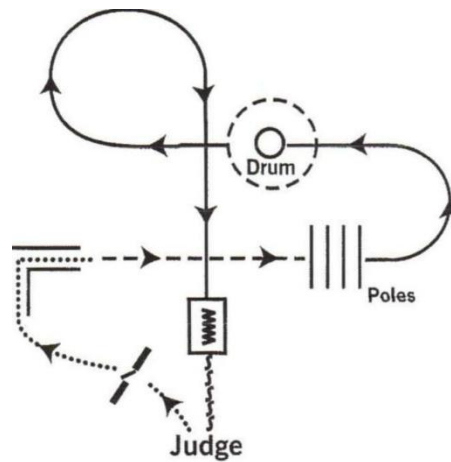
- — - — - Canter - degree of collection

1	Saulte Judge at A
2	Walk to B
3	Rising trot to C (center). Stop.
4	360° spin to the right.
5	360° spin to the left.
6	Trot a medium circle to the right.
7	Trot a medium circle to the left.
8	At C canter a large circle to the right on the right lead.
9	At C do a simple change and canter a large circle to the left on the left lead.
10	At C do a simple change and canter to E on the right lead. Stop.
11	Do a rollback to the left and canter to F on the left lead. Stop.
12	Do a rollback to the right and canter on the right lead all the way to G and stop.
13	Back your horse until you are in line with the judge. Stop.
14	Turn and face the judge, salute. Leave arena on a loose rein.
